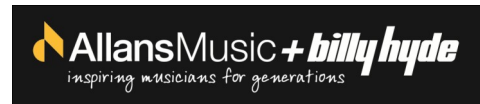

## About Amy Dickson

ClariSax Feast is excited to welcome guest artist Amy Dickson in 2012! Born in Sydney, Amy made her concerto debut at the age of 16 before studying at the Royal College of Music and Amsterdam Conservatorium. She won the Symphony Australia Young Performers Award in 2004. In demand as a soloist, she performs and records with orchestras such as the Royal Philharmonic, Philharmonia and London Philharmonic, among others. In addition to performing the concertos of Glazunov, Debussy, Villa-Lobos, Ibert, Larsson and Milhaud, she champions contemporary repertoire and regularly commissions new works. Her recordings include the CDs *Smile* (2008) and *Glass – Tavener - Nyman* (2009), Carl Davis' score for the film *Hotel du Lac*, and works by Joseph Holbrooke and Richard Rodney Bennett.
